

WEB: Where Everybody Belongs

WEB is a middle school orientation and transition program that welcomes 6th/7th graders and makes them feel comfortable throughout the first year of their middle school experience. Built on the belief that students can help students succeed, the program trains mentors from your 8th grade class to be WEB leaders. As positive role models, WEB Leaders are mentors and student leaders



who guide the 6th/7th graders to discover what it takes to be successful during the transition to middle school and help facilitate 6th/7th grade success. WEB acts as an anti-bullying program by providing it with a cadre of student leaders who look for bullying behavior and help stop it. WEB gives older students permission to be aware of and report any negative behavior they see, creating a safer school for everybody. WEB is a yearlong transition program with four components that contribute to its success: Middle School Orientation, Academic Follow-Ups, Social Follow-Ups and Leader Initiated Contacts.
